
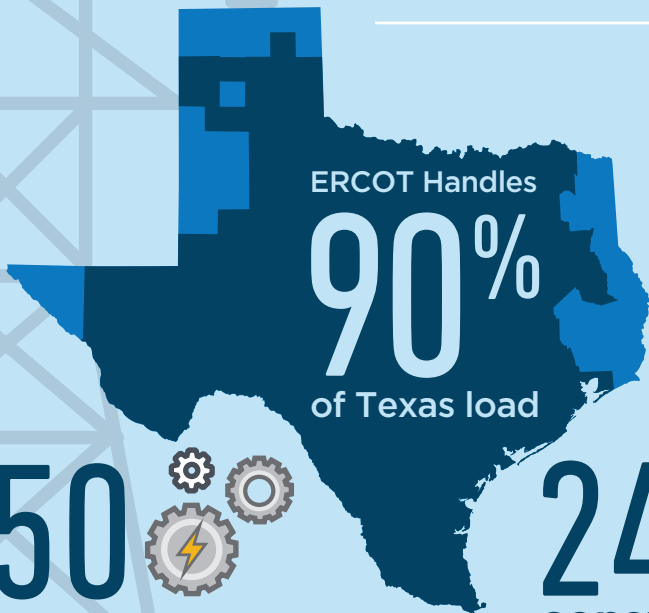




THE ELECTRIC RELIABILITY COUNCIL OF TEXAS

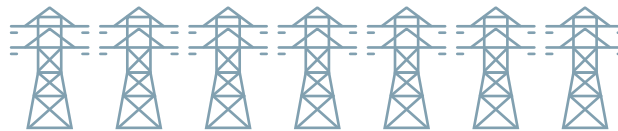
